Why we want you

Access into nature is a really important part of growing up, and we want to support families to get involved and take advantage of their local green spaces. Nature Tots leaders help run sessions on the first Monday of the month over the winter, and twice monthly over the summer. This is a relaxed role helping instigate wild play in Penrith.

What you will be doing

- Helping 2 existing volunteers to facilitate these sessions,
- Delivering games and ideas, encouraging play and nature discovery.
- Parents are always present so the role is relaxed, simply about connecting little ones with their wild side.

The skills you need

No experience required, just enthusiasm for wildlife and young adventurers – you won't be on your own and can learn from us if needed, or else bring along your best nature games, facts and activities. Expenses for you and the session are covered.

- You'll join part of a friendly team
- You can learn new skills or share your existing expertise
- You will contribute to local access to nature within the community
